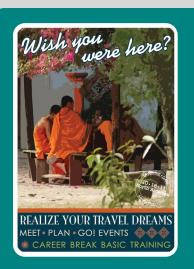

For their Awards Gala, they sought a cohesive design for event materials reflecting their mission.

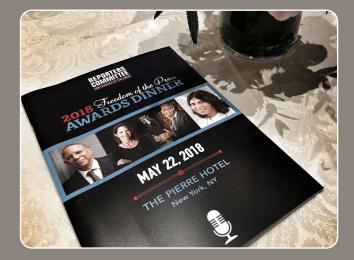

Client Puzzle & Solution

To manage the timing of honoree introductions, pre-produced videos are created, offering a fuller narrative of their achievements.

- I film and transcribe 4-8 interviews for each video and also utilize Zoom interviews when in-person interviews are not possible.
- I edit all videos including creating b-roll and motion graphics.
- I make music selections for all videos.
